Uniforms

4. New Business

- Wind Ensemble Symposium
 - Kyle Harrington from Independence High School will be here Thursday night through potentially Sunday
 - No hotel needed; he will stay with Ross
 - We will reimburse him mileage (\$0.625/mile) as well as pay for his meals and his \$500 honorarium. (\$250 for Friday AND Saturday)
 - Ross will use Booster credit card for all purchase regarding Mr. Harrington.
 - Board all in Favor
- All-VA Auditions
 - This year auditions are back to being live at James Madison University.
 - Tallwood will pay for the students/ lodging, transportation and registration for All-VA Auditions. Ms. Eskins will chaperone the 3 girls and Mr. Rossettini will chaperone the 3 boys so 3 hotel rooms will be needed in Harrisonburg.

- THSBB will pay for the students' meals. 2 dinners and 1 lunch. **Cash will be needed in envelopes to be given to the kids because they will be separated during the day doing their auditions.**
- VBODA Concert Band Assessment
 - THSBB pays for all Director's Hospitality upfront and get's reimbursed by the district. Charges will be made on the credit card for 11-14 people
