## CONCERT BAND ASSESSMENT

#### HARRY POTTER IN CONCERT

- 50 tickets were purchased for HP in Concert, Saturday, March 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2024 2:00pm Chrysler Hall, Norfolk.
- 45 tickets will be available for those students who have their band fees paid in full. (40+ students requires 5 chaperones. Mr. Ross and Lindsey Eskins will be 2 of those 5 chaperones. Three other adults are needed to go.)
- Using the school system's buses to drop/pick up at Chrysler Hall will cost approx.
   \$80
- Full cost of the trip for the band program is approx. \$2,440.00. Divided by 45 to cover the cost of the chaperones, the trip per student should be approx. \$55.00.

# APPLEBEES FUNDRAISER
