- a. Treasurer's Report: projected vs. actual.
 - Currently in the bank the Band Boosters have \$12,291.84 with \$8,072.00 in the CD for replacement of the entire marching band tower.
 - However, there are outstanding invoice payments in the amount of \$6,629.43 which include the final payment for the drill write, the final payment for the color guard uniforms, the Yankee Candle Fundraiser and some small misc. items. So realistically, we have \$5,669.38 at the moment.
 - As of October 10, 2018: **\$24,148.72** is still owed to the Band Program through the Band Boosters.
 - We must continue to push the collection of band fees.
- b. Fundraising: Currently finishing up our last fund raiser: Yankee Candle. Yankee Candle Profit was \$1,901.00.

Walk-a-thon profit to date was \$504.00.

- Yankee Candles are due soon and each order will be labeled when it arrives
