# 6. New Business – ALL INFORMATION REVIEWED NO QUESTIONS ASKED

- Concession logistics: We had nothing but praise from the Tallwood Administration for the concessions stand last game. They will be putting up the stanchions again as we need to run the windows just like the last game.
- Typical Show day:
  - o Call time in the AM
  - Load the trailer, if trailer is done before buses leave send the trailer to the show to start unloading before we get there
  - o Students in full uniform to get on the bus
  - Staff checks out students uniform and instrument
  - Percussion staff check out all instruments and makes sure there is spare sticks, heads, tools, drum key etc. in case of emergency
  - Leave for show
  - o Band arrives and we do bathroom break
  - o After bathrooms, eat banana, granola and water back outside of bus
  - o Line up in full uniform with instrument
  - Head to warm-up
  - Depending on show, pit may or may not warm-up with or without band
  - Meet at gate to stadium for performance time
  - o Perform show
  - Head back to bus/trailer and pack-up
  - Figure out meal if necessary
  - o Sit in away stands and watch remainder of show until end of show
  - Load buses, head home, unpack and dismiss.
    - Trailer may go back to school and unload before we get there to speed up end of night process.
