## e. Financial Report

i. There is an available balance on hand of $\$ 16,976.74$.
ii. There are pending checks for December Staff Salaries and an Invoice for a total expenditure of $\$ 4,100.00$.
iii. This leaves an actual balance of \$11,976.74 in our Checking Account.
iv. Our Money Market Account Balance is $\$ 6,617.20$ with no pending transactions
v. We stretched out the marching fee over seven months to make it easier on families. At this point, returning marching band members should have paid $\$ 300.00$ and new marching band members should have paid \$325.00 of their individual marching band fee.
vi. The full amount of your students marching band fee should be paid at this point.
vii. Payments Options include check, cash, Square or on the website.

ix. We ask that you continually check CHARMS for updates on your student's account.
