- Normal rehearsal schedule for next week:

    - When marching band instrumentalists (those students playing **an** instrument) are in uniform, they will need compression shorts under their bibbers.
    - The Color Guard members will need a clear strap body tight for under their custom-made uniform for this year's show. They need to have the correct underwear support for an athletic activity.
- **The first** competition is at Hickory High School on **September 27th**. The band will be involved with events ALL day: Neptune Parade and we will perform at Hickory in the evening.
- The itinerary will be sent home next week with the students, posted on the band website, and sent home in CutTime.
- Dismissal at the end of a competition evening is very simple. The students will not be dismissed until everything is properly put away and stored correctly. This first competition night will be late.
- We are looking to schedule Band get-togethers November and December. Students will need to have their Band Fees paid off in order to participate in these events.
